Based on Osaka University Admission Policies, the Graduate School of Engineering seeks individuals able to contribute to furthering science and technology and the enhancement of human society. Moreover, they should also possess a high sense of ethics and the motivation and ambition to return the advantages they have enjoyed to international society.

As such, the Graduate School of Engineering hopes to enroll persons possessing these qualities:

- 1. Basic and specialized knowledge and skills in one's area of specialization
- 2. Ability to voluntarily address problems and logically consider solutions
- 3. The ability to express and discuss, convey one's ideas accurately
- 4. English proficiency necessary for communicating with the world

Master's course

In order to select individuals with the above-mentioned qualities, the master's course conducts general entrance examinations consisting of a written and an oral examination. Furthermore, in order to admit students from Japan and abroad possessing great research ability and nurture excellent researchers and engineers, the master's course employs a variety of screening processes: admission by recommendation, special screening for international students, and 3 Courses conducted in English — advanced Education Program for Career Development of Foreign Students from Asia, Erasmus Mundus, and Masters of Photonic NETworks Engineering (MAPNET).

Doctor's course

In order to select individuals with the above-mentioned qualities, the doctor's course conducts general entrance examinations consisting of written and oral examinations. The doctor's course welcomes persons possessing these qualities:

- 1. Advanced knowledge and skills in the field of the applicant's dissertation research
- 2. Ability to summarize research results, to write a thesis, present, and discuss research results. In order to accept students possessing great research ability, the doctor's course conducts special screening for international students and entrance examinations for three Courses conducted in English.
