Based on Osaka University Admission Policies, the School of Dentistry seeks individuals who have creativity enabling them to contributing to health sciences, motivation to become next-generation leaders in a field of dental research and treatment, as well as the following qualities:

1. A wide range of knowledge necessary for learning dental medicine and dental treatment.
2. Excellent communication skills and the ability to exercise care in treating others.
3. Ability to think flexibly and rich humanity and sociability.
4. Ability to respond to progress in society and science and the ability to solve problems independently.
5. A clear sense of purpose and motivation for learning for their entire career.
6. Ability to view the world and contribute to the development of health sciences

In order to acquire these qualities, students need to have had a high level of academic achievement in the sciences (especially, mathematics and science) and liberal arts (Japanese, English, and social studies) in senior high school. They also need to work on improving communication skills, human qualities, and social skills. The School of Dentistry assesses these abilities through an entrance examination consisting of an achievement test(s) and an interview.
