Currently, the Pharmaceutical Sciences at Osaka University has two courses: a four-year course at the Department of Pharmacy and a six-year course at the Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences. The Department of Pharmacy seeks students who want to dedicate themselves to studying life science, drug discovery science, and social pharmacy from perspective of basic pharmacy and contributing to health sciences and environmental pharmacy.
