School of Science

Based on Osaka University Admission Policies, in order to accept persons who are likely to achieve its education objectives meeting the requirements noted below, the School of Science conducts entrance examinations using multiple screening methods:

- 1. Two divisions of general screening: general quota and special quota
- 2. Comprehensive screening process with an emphasis on an interview and essay
- 3. Screening of students who have taken part in the International Science Olympiad as Representatives of Japan is conducted through post-Olympiad interviews
- 4. Special entrance exams consisting of an interview and achievement test Entrance Examination for Applicants Graduating from Overseas High Schools, Screening for Privately-Funded International Students, and Special English Entrance Examinations.

The School of Science seeks individuals such as those noted below:

- Individuals who completed the curriculum at senior high school and those certified as having academic ability equivalent to that of a graduate of upper secondary school.
- Individuals who are interested in natural science and feel happy in taking the initiative in ascertaining truth and sharing it with others
- Individuals who have a wide range of knowledge in natural science as well as a broad perspective and flexible mindset, and are able to convey their ideas
- Individuals who can contribute to society using their scientific knowledge
