- You should have a habit of always checking the bulletin board and accessing KOAN.
- In case of necessity such as emergency contact or document sending, we may contact your address or your telephone number etc. which you delivered in advance.

※You can use KOAN to register for courses, register for addresses, searching syllabi, access the message boards, confirm canceled / make-up classes or answer questionnaires, over the internet. (KOAN is the name for the University's academic administration information system) Access Osaka University Campus-wide IT Authentication Service page (<https://my.osaka-u.ac.jp>), and log in to myhandai with your own ID and password, after that, click "KOAN" icon. Please make full use of KOAN through your student life.


**Let's make good use of e-mail forwarding function of KOAN !**

	<b>Liability Insurance for Students Pursuing Education and Research (LSR)</b> This insurance insures one against personal liability claims in the case of injury to someone or damage to another person's property during internships, teaching practices and other practices, or volunteer activities. Students pursuing education are strongly encouraged to participate in this insurance.	
	<b>Comprehensive Insurance</b> This insurance covers a wider range than that covered by PAS.
