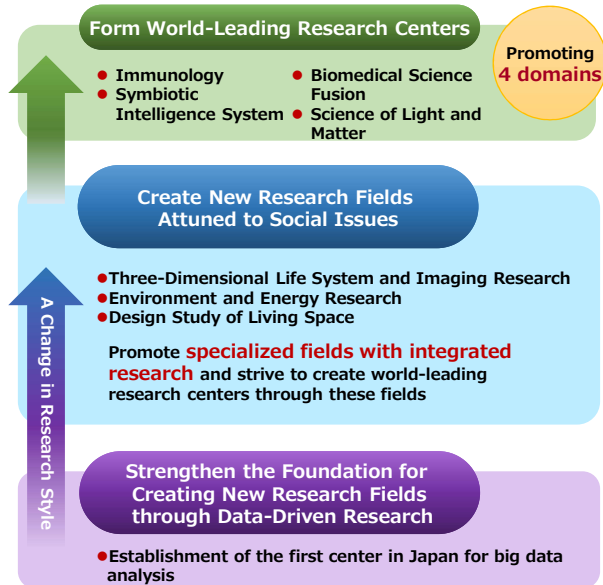
Our Ideal Model for a World-Leading Innovative University



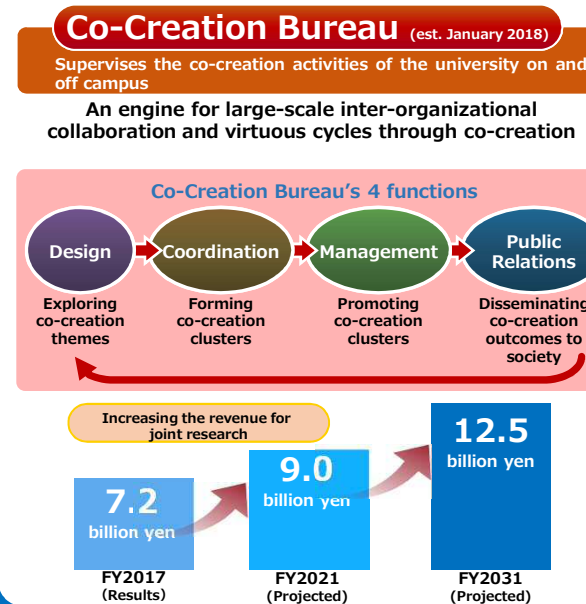
Basic Concept

Educating/Acquiring Talent with a Mind for Co-Creation

- Advanced Programs in Liberal Arts** (Comprehensive liberal arts programs across the board)
- Education in advanced transferrable skills
 - Entrepreneurship education, etc.
 - Provide education in Critical Thinking, Transcultural Communicability, and Design Prowess to solve social issues
- Development of New Degree Programs** (Graduate level)
- Program for Prominent Graduate Schools
 - Program for Leading Graduate Schools, etc.
 - Nurture PhD holders who can work in academia as well as generate innovation for society

Governance Restructuring

Swift decision-making for optimum university management

- Osaka University Provosts [Two Senior Executive Vice Presidents responsible for "university management" and "education and research"]
- Three strategic meetings focusing on three independent topics [promote policies and explore themes that develop bridges of communication between departments]
- Strengthen university-wide risk management systems

Strengthening the Financial Base

Financial improvement plan to strengthen research capacity, collaboration with society, and international collaboration

- Boost self-generated income through the virtuous cycles developed by the Co-Creation Bureau and the expansion of large-scale inter-organization collaborations
- Increase donation revenue by utilizing domestic and international networks of alumni, etc.
