We would like to once again introduce the Harassment Counseling Office.

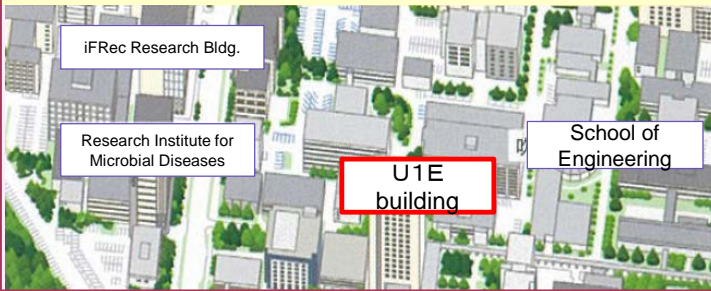
Where is the Harassment Counseling Office?

There is a Harassment Counseling Office located on each of the three campuses: Suita, Toyonaka, and Minoh.

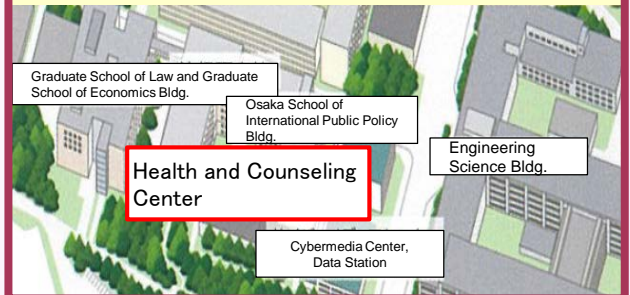
Suita Campus	School of Engineering, Building U1E, 4 th floor
