

## **School of Economics**

The School of Economics seeks persons who will persist in studying economics and business administration, open a path suitable to their aptitude, thereby attaining notable achievement in their fields in the future.

Based on Osaka University Admission Policies, the School of Economics selects students with such potential through the examinations made by the National Center for University Entrance Examinations and the Individual Achievement Examinations.

- (1) Using multiple evaluation methods, the school selects students by checking applicants' basic knowledge and understanding of Japanese, geography, history, civics, science, mathematics, and foreign language at high school through the examinations made by the National Center for University Entrance Examinations and the [February or March] Individual Achievement Examinations.
- (2) In order to select qualified students, the school allows applicants to choose examination subjects from among the many options in the examinations made by the National Center for University Entrance Examinations; thus, even applicants who studied mainly natural science subjects at senior high school can take the Individual Achievement Examinations.
- (3) In order to select not only persons with comprehensive ability, but also those of high ability in specific fields, in judging applicants' scores in the examination made by the National Center for University Entrance Examinations and the Individual Achievement Examinations, the school uses multiple point allocation so that it can select students by considering both total scores and outstanding scores in specific fields in a comprehensive manner.
- (4) For international students, by conducting Screening for Privately-funded International Students, the school assesses applicants' basic knowledge and Japanese language proficiency and, in particular, mathematics in order to select those having logical thinking power and those are highly motivated.
