Tuition Fee Exemption for the second semester for Sudden Income Loss due to the COVID-19 situation

If you meet both "1. Applicant" and "2. Application criteria " listed below, you can apply for the Tuition Fee exemption for the second semester for Sudden Income Loss due to the COVID-19 situation. Tuition Fee exemption on this appendix is different from the regular Osaka University Tuition Fee Exemption for the second semester and selection will be made based on different criteria.

The Tuition Fee Exemption will be sponsored by the government's special budget, in case the government does not provide the special budget, your application will be forwarded to the regular Osaka University Tuition Fee Exemption.

Note 1. If you are eligible for **高等教育修学支援制度(receiving financial support or planning to apply)**, apply for its 家計急変採用.

Note 2. Student, "2. Application criteria" on the instructions do not apply to and wishes to apply for the regular Osaka University Tuition Fee Exemption, read "Instructions for Application for Osaka University Exemption, Deferred Payment or Payment by Installments of the Tuition Fee" and apply for the Tuition Fee Exemption. If you do not meet the requirements in the instructions, you cannot apply.

Application instructions vary depend on student, please apply with the right application instructions (Undergraduate Enrolled in 2021 · · · Application Instructions [A], Undergraduate admitted in/before 2020 · · · Application Instructions [B], Graduate Student · · · Application Instructions [C]).

1. Applicant

Due to the COVID-19 situation, undergraduates and graduates with decreased household supporter 's(\times 1) income(\times 2) compared to the time before the outbreak.

In principle, "Self-supporting student" is an applicant who earns (and/or applicant's spouse earns) sufficient and continuous income to cover all the expenses for a whole year and make living on his/her/their own income. In case of doubt, the univeristy will check the requirements and advice the applicant to chage the application category to "General student".
