1. Supervise and teach laboratory students. Teach assigned courses on information systems engineering at the graduate level and those on computer science at the undergraduate level.

- 9) Plan on teaching and research at Osaka University (within one page). Put the date on which the applicant can join the position;
- 10) List of four possible references, two from Japan and two from outside Japan. Indicate name, affiliation, title, and contact information for each reference;
- 11) Electrical scanned copy of the above 1) to 10) documents recorded in a CD-R or other digital medium.
