Outline	<p>The Cybermedia Center at Osaka University is recruiting a female faculty member who has an interest in language and culture, and also a strong interest and skills in e-Learning systems and the computer assisted foreign language learning system CALL (Computer Assisted Language Learning) and in developing Web-based teaching materials.</p> <p>Skills and knowledge of e-Learning systems, CALL, Web teaching materials may be acquired by practice after joining the center. Therefore, the center is looking forward to applications of researchers in areas of social sciences, humanities, science, and technology, regardless of their specialties. Please classify publications into categories such as original papers, international conference papers, books, review articles, tutorial articles, patents, etc. * "With" or "without" peer-reviews must be indicated for original papers and international conference papers.</p> <p>(3) Five(5) copies of three(3) major original papers.</p> <p>(4) Outline of major research(es) and its achievement(s) (about 1,000 characters.)</p> <p>(5) Research plan and short essay on education (about 1,000 characters.)</p> <p>(6) A copy of diploma or certificate of doctoral course.</p> <p>(7) A copy of Japanese proficiency certificate (if applicant's native language is not Japanese.)</p> <p>(8) Two(2) letters of recommendations. *Name, affiliation, contact information of the recommenders must be included. (The recommenders may be directly asked their opinions.)</p> <p>*Submitted application documents are not returned to the applicants.</p>
