

**Job Opening at Center for the Study of Co\* Design, Osaka University, as Specially Appointed Associate Professor (Lecturer) (Full Time) or Specially Appointed Assistant Professor (Full Time)**

The Center for the Study of Co\* Design at Osaka University is aiming to create the learning system, "Training Program for Developing Advanced Comprehensive Skills," that can nurture the power to innovate in the society, namely the power to discover and solve problems and to acquire practical transferrable skills.

A position is now open for an academic member of staff with the ability to contribute to teaching and research, directed at discovering societal problems and create solutions through interpersonal support based on the Graduate Program for Advanced Interdisciplinary Studies "Clinical Approach to Social Vulnerability."

**4. Content of Work:**

- (1) Work duties relating to the development, management and execution of an education program for carrying out communication processes, discovering problems and societal implementation, intending to find problems and solutions through societal and interpersonal support.
- (2) Work duties relating to the management of the Center for the Study of Co\* Design. Inclusive of design and improvement of the Graduate Program for Advanced Interdisciplinary Studies "Clinical Approach to Social Vulnerability" and Graduate Minor Programs, and other duties including educational affairs and public relations.
- (3) Practical teaching and research in interpersonal support and care for minority groups.

**5. Required Skills and Experiences:**

- (1) Must be able to develop Socratic dialogue method based curriculums for communication training as one of the advanced comprehensive skills in confronting problems encountered through interpersonal support, and also be able to lead and delegate this curriculum.
- (2) Must be able to plan and manage tasks relating to the development of the above curriculums.
- (3) Must have experience in joint teaching/research in the areas of health care, social welfare and clinical philosophy.
