Selection Process	<p>After documents have been reviewed, only shortlisted candidates will be interviewed (if necessary).  *Shortlisted candidates will be notified within three weeks from the deadline. Please note that unsuccessful applicants after initial screening will not be contacted.  *Travel and accommodation fees necessary for interviews are to be covered by the candidate.</p>
