

## Faculty Position in the Graduate School of Medicine, Osaka University

Outline	Osaka University Graduate School of Medicine decided to select a candidate for Professor of Advanced Life Science and Medical Science field (For instance, multiple organ network, whole-body metabolic control, and neuroimmune network), which will be newly introduced as a promising research field. The appointed professor is assumed to be engaged in research activities and will also be responsible for lectures and practical training on Advanced Life Science and Medical Science field for undergraduate students of medical school. In addition, the professor will be in charge of education for graduate students. He/She will be able to select and hire an associate professor and two assistant professors.
