

# Osaka University's COVID-19 response levels (as of 11 June)

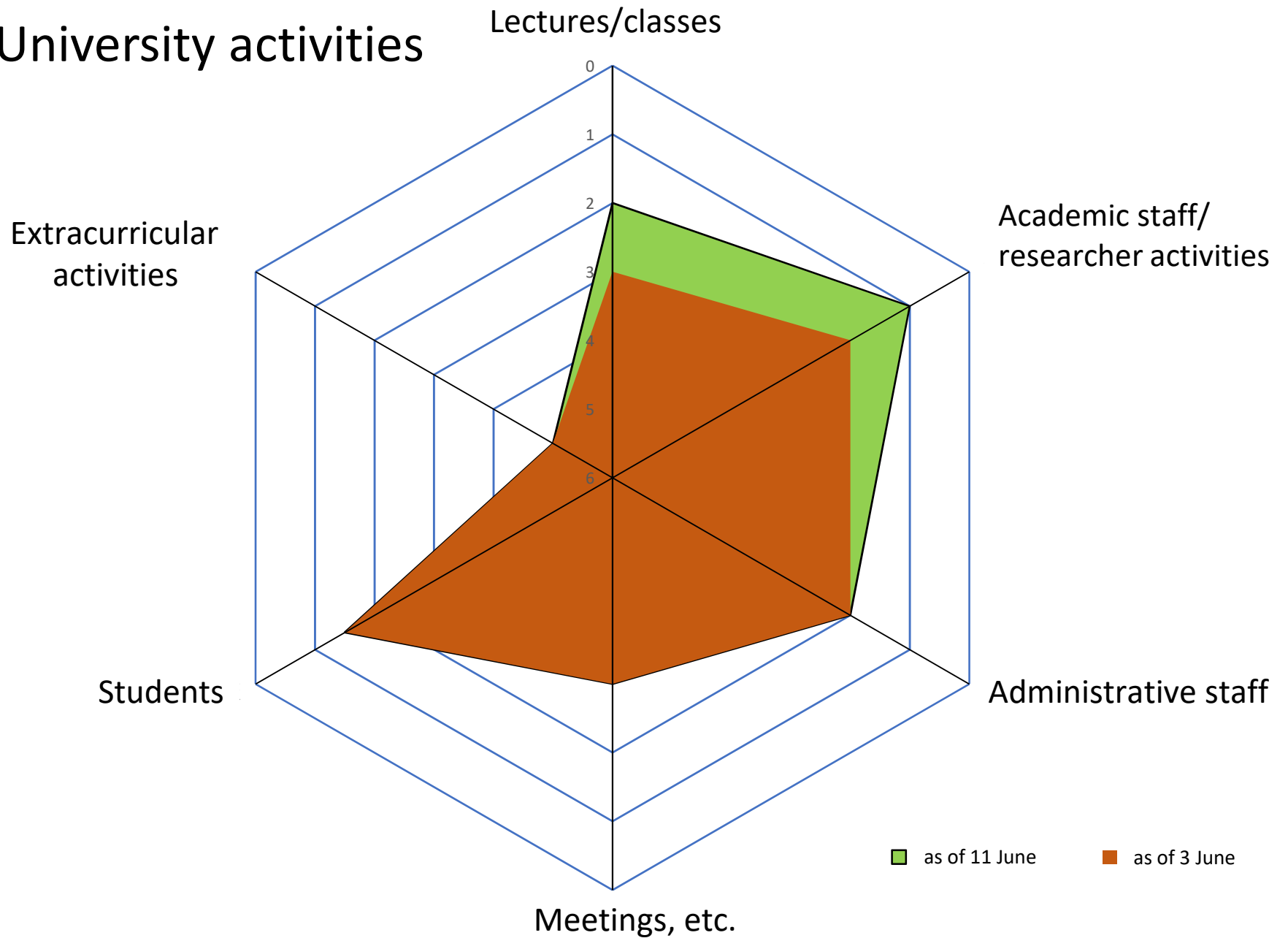
In order to respond properly and flexibly to the government's policies and requests concerning COVID-19, Osaka University will implement the following measures regarding university activities.

The following slides present a visualization of levels of response regarding 6 categories of university activity.

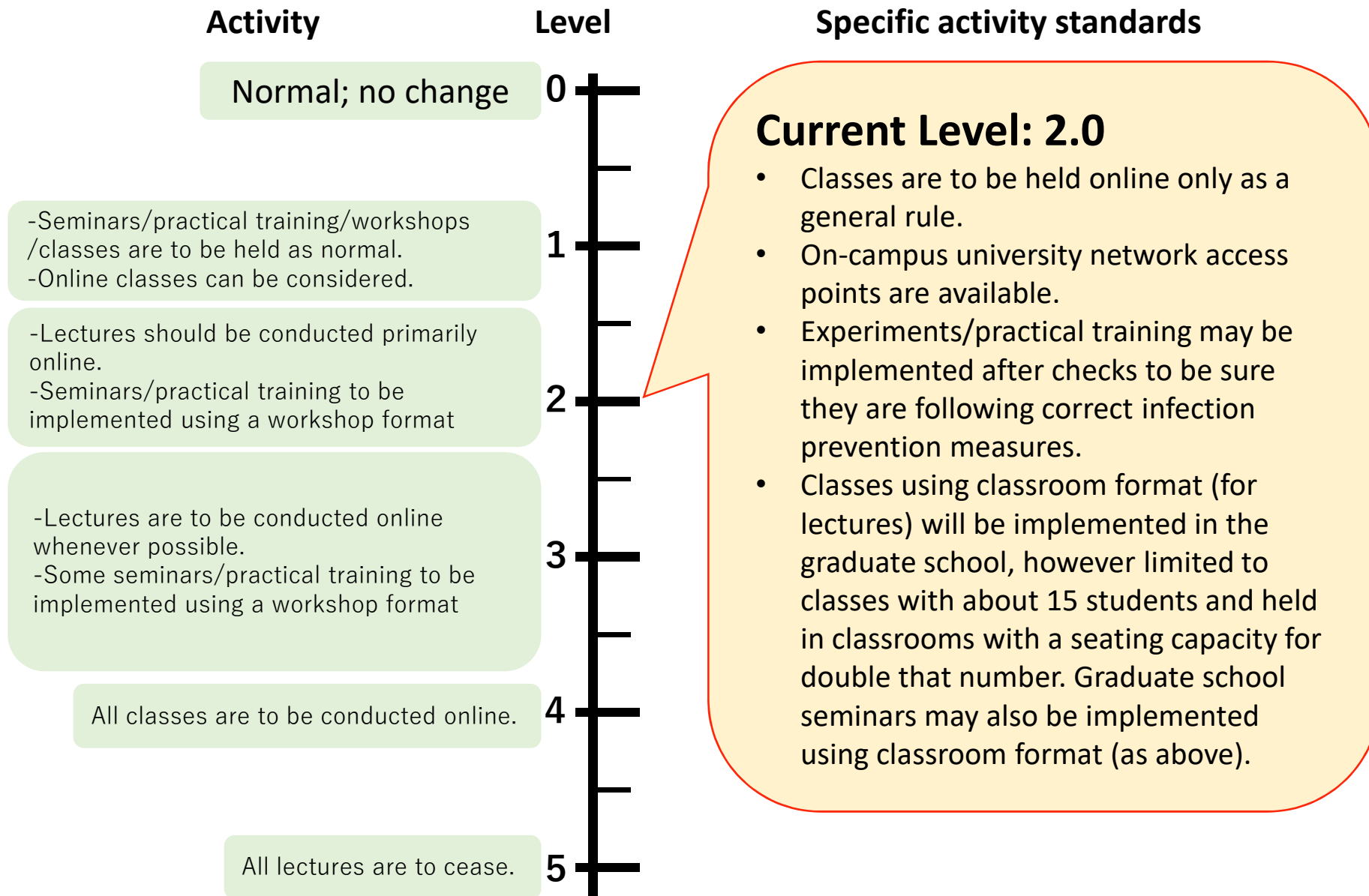

6. Extracurricular activities

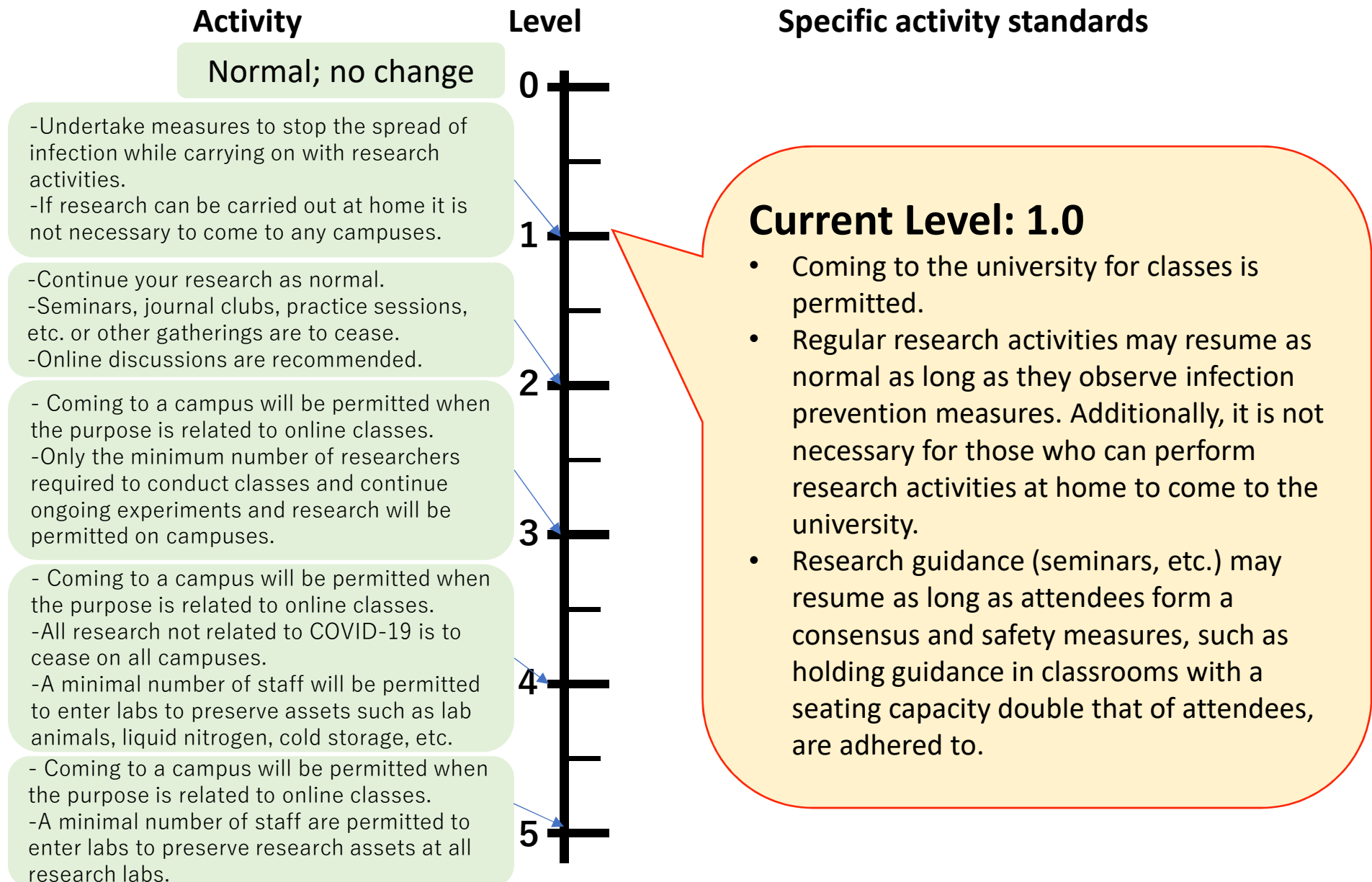

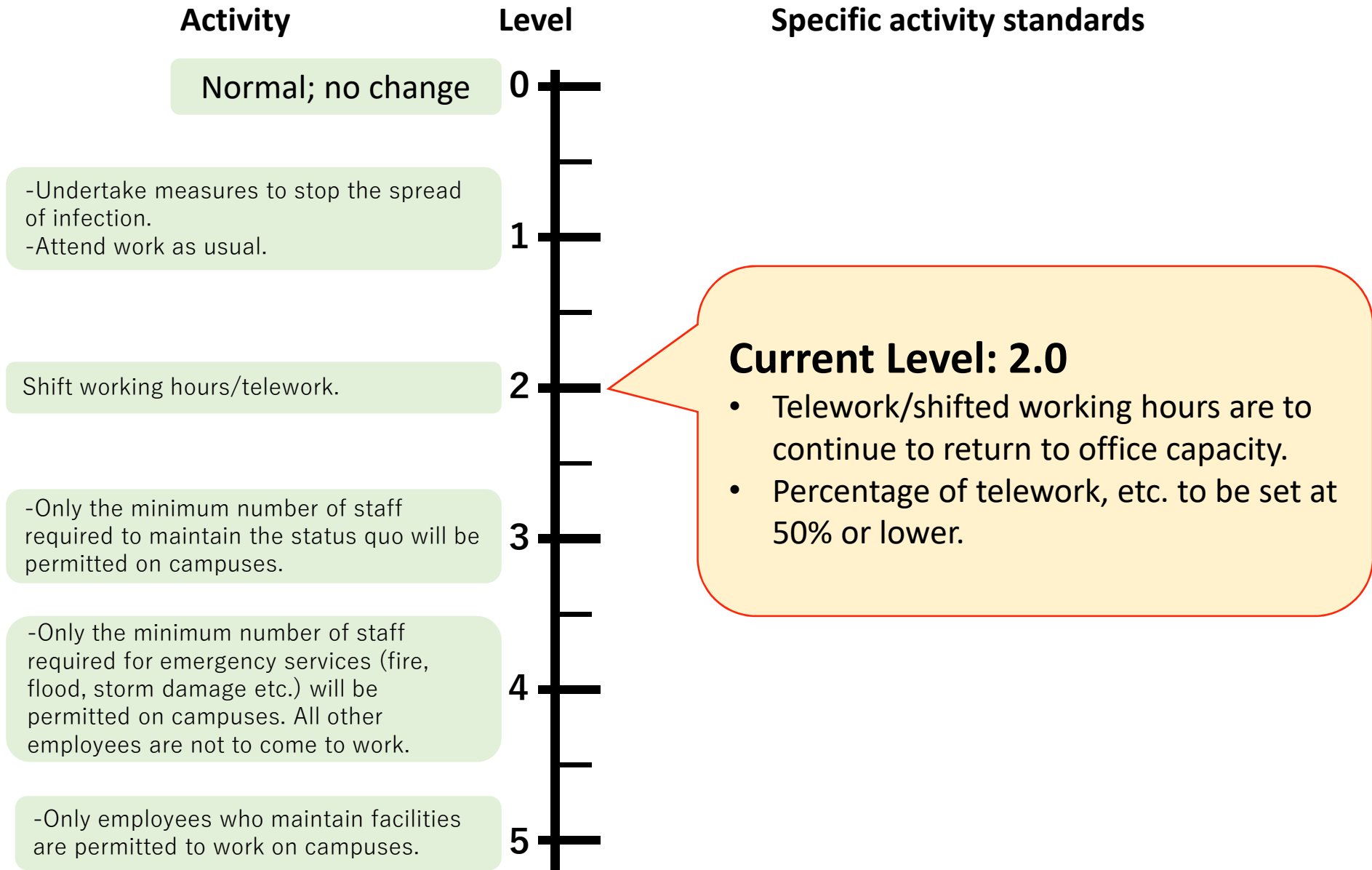

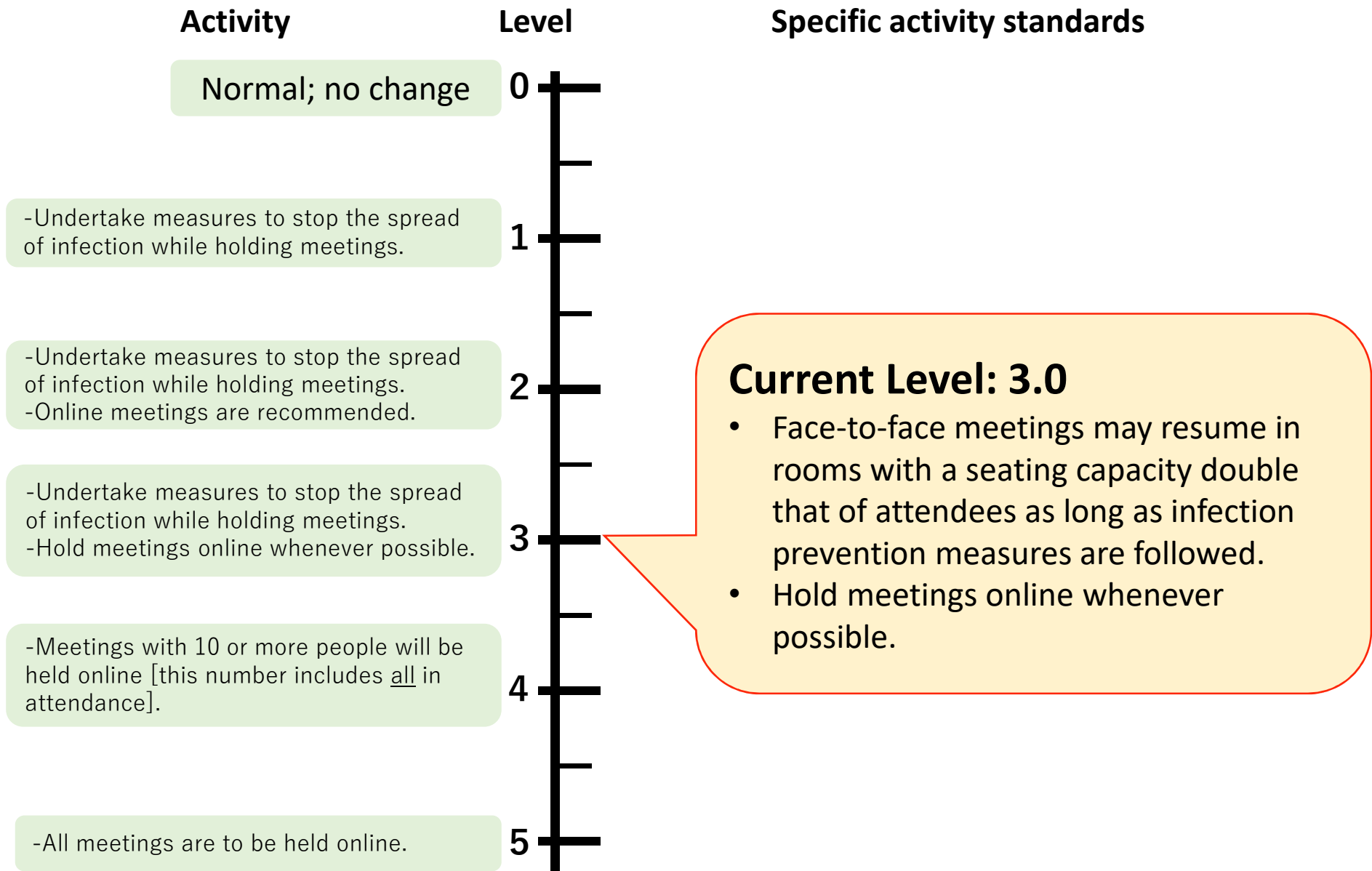

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Undergraduate students are <u>not</u> to come to the university.</li> <li>-Graduate students are to refrain from coming to the university whenever possible.</li> </ul>	2	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Undergraduate/graduate students are not permitted to come to any campus. However, this does not include graduate students with ongoing experiments or research.</li> </ul>	3	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>-Graduate students/researchers, etc. whose research is not related to COVID-19 are to cease coming to the university.</li> </ul>	4	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students are to cease coming to the university.</li> </ul>	5
