

Infection Prevention Measures

- Adhere to infection prevention measures (wear a mask at all times, wash your hands with soap and water or alcohol disinfectant, etc.).
- Practice social distancing.
- Refrain from eating with people other than your family.
- Those who have daily contact with the elderly should avoid high-risk situations.
- Follow the government's request for outings in your daily life.

Staying Healthy

- Check your temperature every morning. If you have a fever and/or cough or cold-like symptoms, refrain from coming to the University.
Symptoms that have subsided may reappear, so continue to check your temperature and avoid meeting whenever possible.
- Immediately contact a primary care doctor or health care center (新型コロナ受診相談センター) if you develop symptoms such as fever or fatigue.
- If you have been infected with COVID-19 or if a health care center deems that you have had close contact with someone who has been infected, you are requested to immediately contact the faculty/school/graduate school/center you are affiliated with by phone, etc. Additionally, if you are unable to contact your affiliated faculty/school/graduate school/center due to it being a holiday/after working hours, please send them an email and CC the Department for the Administration of Safety and Hygiene [covid-19@dash.osaka-u.ac.jp].
