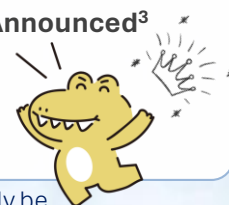

Grant Eligibility Requirements

- ✓ The lead applicant must have presented a poster at this event.
- ✓ The Research collaboration must have been initiated through this event.
- ✓ The collaboration must be between researchers from different graduate schools or institutes.
- ✓ The lead applicant plans to continue the collaborative research at UOsaka after April 2027.

Poster Preparation

Your poster should address the following 3 questions:

- ✓ **“What are you researching?”**
Current status, challenges, and future outlook.
 - ✓ **“What can you contribute?”**
Your strengths, skills, and resources.
 - ✓ **“What expertise or ideas are you looking for?”**
Expertise, ideas, or technologies you would like to connect with.
- Size: Up to 90cm (W) × 160cm (H)
 - Language: Japanese or English

You can reuse your existing poster.**
