1. APRU Overview

The Association of Pacific Rim Universities (APRU), founded in 1997, is an association established by university presidents of representative Pacific Rim countries. The aims of this association are to strengthen bilateral cooperation in higher education and, through cooperation and contributions in education and research, work together on serious problems facing Pacific Rim societies such as economic development, urbanization, technology transfer, atmospheric pollution, and the depletion of resources. 57 member universities(as of April, 2021) hold workshops, symposiums, and international conferences.

Osaka University has been a member of APRU since its founding and OU students and researchers have participated in its various events.

- The implementation period of the courses varies depending on the courses.
- The deadline for each course varies from universities. For details, please refer to the VSE website list of courses in [9.] below. Some have already completed their course deadlines.
- Regarding credit transfer for the courses the applicants have taken, please inquire with the Academic Affairs Section of the School which the applicants belong to.
