We strongly recommend you to check with the institutions you are applying for about the requirements before registering.

- ◆If you do not bring a valid passport with you on the test day, you will NOT be allowed to take the test. If you need to renew your passport or use it for visa purposes, please make sure that you plan accordingly so that the valid passport can be brought to the test site on the day of the test. THE VALID PASSPORT BROUGHT TO THE TEST SITE MUST BE THE ONE YOU SUBMITTED COPIES OF TO THE IELTS OFFICE DURING REGISTRATION. If you renew your passport, you must inform the IELTS Office and submit a copy of your new passport by 17:00 4 days before the test. Failure to do so will result in not being able to take the test.

- ◆If you wish to cancel, you may do so online by 17:00, 8th May. Please note that an administration fee of 6,300JPY (including tax) is charged for this service.
